- 4) Books must be published in the USA even if they are printed elsewhere
- 5) Three copies of each book, submitted for consideration, will NOT be returned whether the book is accepted or not.

ISNA is sure that this will be an enlightening and lasting experience for all participants. If you have a publication that you would like to submit for consideration, please let us know.

Deadline for submissions is April 12, 2010

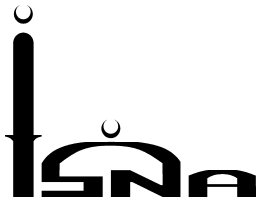

A. Convention Registration

- Each participating author in the 2010 Meet the Author program will receive one complimentary registration to the 2010 ISNA Convention.

- To obtain your official speakers name badge, please go to the *Speakers Booth* in the registration area upon arrival at the convention center.

B. Hotel and Transportation

- ISNA is not responsible for travel and hotel accommodations. Each participating author is required to make his or her own travel and hotel arrangements and will be responsible for the payment of such. C. Book Sales

- Each author will have the opportunity to sell his or her book at the conclusion of the session at a table that will be located in the room where the presentation is held for the allocated time.
