### **Guidelines for Submission**

Your submission must include the following:

- 1 Title
- 2 Abstract
- ③ Proposal
- 4 Short Bio
- Short video of a new or previous presentation (NEW)
- Title of Proposed Session: The Title of the proposal should not exceed ten (10) words and should capture the essence of the presentation.
- Abstract: The Abstract must be between 50-75 words. The abstract is a brief summary of the proposal. your abstract should indicate the results or outcomes of the work you have done so far. Finally, your abstract should close with a statement of the project's implications and contributions to its field. The content of the abstract will be the basis for acceptance of paper presentation at the international research conference. If selected for presentation at the forum, this abstract will appear in the conference program.
- Proposal: This is the full description of the presentation. The Proposal may not exceed 500 words. Proposals that are too short and lack details may be denied. Description of the presentation in outline format or as a PPT is an acceptable form for submission.
- Biography: The Biography should include:
   Please send your biography using the following format:

- 1 Full name
- ② Position/department/organization/country
- ③ Biography (word count should not exceed 75 words) If selected to speak at the conference, the bio will appear in the conference program
- Contact information (address, contact/mobile number, email address, Twitter account
   LinkedIn account)
- **5** Color photograph

If the proposal is accepted, the presenter will be required to submit the following by **March 26th**, **2023:** 

- Complete paper/PowerPoint
- Annotated bibliography

#### **Accommodations for Presenters:**

- Shared hotel rooms will be provided for Friday and Saturday (two nights), with 3 meals and a complimentary registration to the lead presenter in each session.
- Requests for reimbursement of travel cost, up to \$250, will be considered for the lead presenter in each session.

Please Note: Speakers MUST be present for the duration of the conference.
